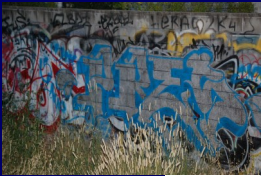


Department Mission Statement

Job Description and Duties:

The Police Service Aides are a distinguished group of volunteers who have a desire to improve the quality of life of the citizens of Rohnert Park by augmenting the duties of Sworn and Civilian staff members of the Department of Public Safety. Police Service Aides will have an opportunity to work in one or more of the listed areas:

- *Parking Enforcement*
- *Traffic control*
- *High visibility shopping center patrol*
- *Crime scene security*
- *Graffiti abatement*
- *Clerical functions within various bureaus*
- *Public Relations events*
- *Neighborhood Watch facilitation*
- *DUI Check-points*
- *Data Entry*

Volunteers—

Can be an important part of any organization and are proven to be a valuable asset to law enforcement agencies. Volunteers help to increase police responsiveness, service delivery, and information input, and they provide new program opportunities. In addition, volunteers can bring new skills and expertise to the job and prompt new enthusiasm. It is the policy of The Rohnert Park Department of Public Safety to use qualified volunteers for specified tasks and duties that can create efficiencies for the department and improve services to the community. Volunteers are intended to supplement and support, rather than supplant, sworn officers and civilian staff.

Who Can Apply?

Candidates must:

- Possess a high-school diploma or G.E.D. from an accredited educational institution.
- Be at least 18 years of age at time of application
- Be free from any felony convictions or certain misdemeanor convictions.
- Have a clean driving record that reflects responsible driving habits.
- Live or work within the City of Rohnert Park.
- Be willing to commit 12 hours per month and attend 1 meeting a month.
- Possess the desire to volunteer for the City of Rohnert Park.
