

CONCEALED WEAPONS PERMITS

To obtain an application for a License to Carry A Concealed Weapon (CCW), please call (707) 584-2650.

Upon completion of the CCW Application, you will need to make an appointment with the CCW Investigator for evaluation. (707) 584-2650.

After approval by the Director of Public Safety, the application will then be sent to the California Department of Justice. Approximately 90 days will be necessary for the processing of your application by D.O.J. When prints are returned, you will be contacted to return to the Department of Public Safety for a photo and your license.

The following fees must be submitted with the CCW Application:

INITIAL APPLICANT FEES

1. *Payable to The City of Rohnert Park:*

License/Fingerprinting Fee = \$ 43.00

2. *Payable to the California Department of Justice:*

90-Day Employment CCW = \$ 73.00

Two-Year Resident CCW = \$ 90.00

Three-Year Judicial CCW = \$ 107.00

Four-Year Reserve Peace Officer CCW = \$ 124.00

RENEWAL FEES

1. *Payable to the California Department of Justice:*

90-Day Employment CCW Renewal = \$ 25.00

Two-Year Resident CCW Renewal = \$ 42.00

Three-Year Judicial CCW Renewal = \$ 59.00

Four-Year Reserve Peace Officer CCW Renewal = \$ 76.00

RENEWAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Applicants for license renewal must have on file all documents required for new applications and must have completed the Firearms Course within the last three years.
2. Any changes in address, employer, occupation or weapon(s) must be reported when they occur.
3. Your thumbprint and signature will be required on the new license form.
4. You must surrender any prior license you hold at the time you pay fees for the new license.
5. Final review of applications rests with the Director of Public Safety. Successful completion of the application steps does not guarantee issuance of a Concealed Weapons License.
6. If in the opinion of the director of Public Safety, an applicant has had an equivalent course of instruction in firearms safety, he may waive the local course requirement. Present documented proof of instruction when requesting a waiver.
