4. Election of Officers (Action)

Rohnert Park Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee Handbook, Section 6A, Election of Officers: "The officers of the BPAC shall be elected annually at the last regular meeting held during the calendar year, or as needed to fill vacancies. The term of office shall begin on the next scheduled meeting after the election and shall be for one (1) year, through the next election. Any such officer shall not be prohibited from succeeding himself or herself, however officers shall serve no more than two (2) consecutive terms, unless so requested by City staff. Nominations will be taken from the floor.

5. Vision Zero Initiative (Presentation by Sonoma County Department of Health Services)

Vision Zero is a multi-national road traffic safety project that aims to achieve a highway and roads system with no fatalities or serious injuries involving road traffic. Sonoma County Transportation Authority and Department of Health Services are collaborating to engage the community in a comprehensive, countywide Vision Zero planning process, building upon the efforts and successes of the Safe Streets Coalition, Safe Routes to School, ECO2School Program, and other community-based efforts to make our roads safer.
