4. SENIOR CENTER REPORT

a. Community Services Supervisor

i. Senior Engagement Update


Community Services Supervisor, Foley provided an update on the senior drive-thru event program. Since the last meeting, the Senior Center, in partnership with Home Instead Senior Care, hosted a free hot chocolate drive-thru event as well as a free drive-thru Valentine Day flower giveaway in partnership with Chinese Christian Church. Foley announced an upcoming spring theme gift bag giveaway taking place on April 16. Councilmember Stafford asked when the Senior Center will reopen. Deputy Director Bagley reported that since there is no specific guidance for Senior Centers, the default is to follow gathering guidelines, which leaves the department at a standstill for reopening the Senior Center. Community Services Supervisor Foley reported senior wellness calls are still taking place on a monthly basis.

ii. Council on Aging Update

Community Services Supervisor, Foley reported Council on Aging will continue to do the curbside meal pick up service for the foreseeable future. Foley reported that the Council on Aging serves approximately 30 seniors at the weekly distribution.
