a. Student Exchange Program Budget Update

i. Rotary Club of Sonoma Mountain Twilight Partnership

Community Services Supervisor, Foley shared with the Committee that since the last meeting, staff presented an item to City Council to let them know that the Rotary Club of Sonoma Mountain Twilight had agreed to be the funding source for the Sister Cities Committee Student Exchange Program. Community Services Supervisor, Foley also shared that when writing the report for City Council that staff uncovered a lot of information about the history and intent of the Sister Cities Committee. Foley shared that according to the resolution that authorized the Sister City relationship the Sister Cities program should involve all aspects of the community and should be a community wide effort. Chair Lorenz reported that at the most recent board meeting, the Rotary Club of Sonoma Mountain Twilight shared they would no longer be able to be the funding source for the Sister Cities Committee Student Exchange Program.
