Dear Rohnert Park Businesses,

California has met the first vaccine equity goal of at least 2 million doses administered, and is updating tier reassignments!

## <u>Under the new thresholds, Sonoma County will be eligible to move from the Purple</u> ("Widespread") Tier into the Red ("Substantial") Tier this Sunday, March 14, 2021.

What does this mean? In part:

•Restaurants can operate indoors with 25% (or 100 people, whichever is fewer)

- ·Gyms can operate indoors with 10% capacity
- •Movie Theatres can operate indoors with 25% (or 100 people, whichever is fewer)
- ·Retail Stores can operate with 50% capacity
- ·Grocery Stores can operate at 100% capacity

## What do you need to know? For starters:

- Where the state sets an indoor capacity percentage limit in the Red Tier, then the total indoor capacity can be determined by using the posted fire maximum capacity limit AND ability of individuals from different households to be able to continue to maintain social distancing. Where there is no posted fire maximum capacity limit, please contact Rohnert Park Public Safety at 707-584-2600.
- The County could move back into the Purple Tier if three metrics (daily case rate, overall positivity rate, and health equity positivity rate) fall back within the Purple Tier for two consecutive weeks.

What do you need to do?
