

Follow these rules to STAY SAFE and AVOID A TICKET!



Motorized Scooters

With or without a seat

- Driver license or permit is required
- Properly fitted and fastened bicycle helmet is required
- Cannot exceed 15 mph
- Ride in the bike lane, not on the sidewalk
- Ride in the direction of vehicle traffic
- Wear close-toed shoes, reflective gear, and don't text or wear earbuds while riding
- · Obey all the rules of the road

Head injuries from e-scooter crashes have TRIPLED in recent years



Pocket Bikes

- Ride on private property only
- Cannot ride in parks, on school property, or on trails, roads, or sidewalks
- Bike can be impounded for violations

With or without pedals

With an automatic transmission
Capable of up to 30 mph

- Motorcycle license is required
- DOT-certified motorcycle helmet is required
- Cannot exceed 20 mph
- Insurance might not cover crashes

Capable of no more than 20 mph
Less than 1000 watt output

- Rider must be at least 16 years old
- Properly fitted and fastened bicycle helmet is required
